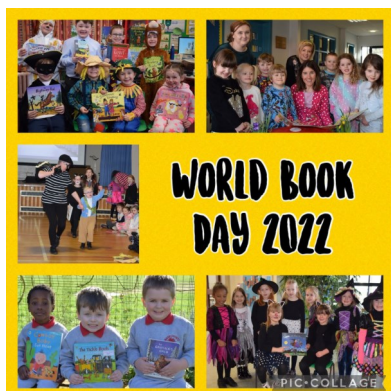


WORLD BOOK DAY

SCHOOL COUNCIL



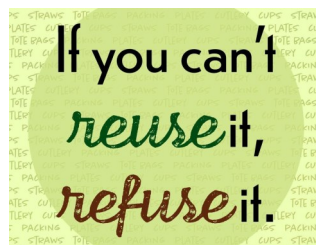
