P.D.M.U.

SchoolCucled

As part of our P.D.M.U. Curriculum, our staff have been availing of training in Beyond Bricks and Nurture Training.

BEYOND BRICKS- is a Lego Based Play which uses a "recovery to discovery" approach, to enhance children's overall mental health and well-being, both now and in the future. This is at present being introduced with Yr 6 and 7.

NURTURE IN FIVE - provides emotional health and well-being strategies and techniques which all classes will be implementing over the next few months.

DEMENTIA NI - are running an intergenerational dementia awareness programme with Rm 5 and Rm 8. This will look at understanding how the brain works and introducing dementia awareness, both in the family and within the community. With the increase in the number of families with loved ones being diagnosed with dementia this will provide children with a greater understanding of the condition.
